



## THE FIRST META-REASONING CONFERENCE

The 1st Meta-Reasoning Conference will be held on December 4-6, 2022 at the **Israel Institute for Advanced Studies** (IIAS), The Hebrew University of Jerusalem, Israel. The conference is organized by the IIAS Research Group "Meta Reasoning: Concepts, Open Issues and Methodology".

Meta-reasoning research focuses on the metacognitive processes which accompany reasoning and problem solving. This conference intends to bring together researchers interested in this domain for sharing and disseminating research findings on this topic.

Keynote talks will be given by:

- Rakefet Ackerman (Technion Israel Institute of Technology, Israel) Klaus Fiedler (University of Heidelberg, Germany)
- Asher Koriat (University of Haifa, Israel) Valerie Thompson (University of Saskatchewan, Canada)

This meeting is planned as an in-person event. All presentations will be given in-person at the IIAS, located in the Feldman building of the Edmond J. Safra Campus (Givat Ram). Presentations will be streamed synchronously via a virtual online platform to accommodate anyone who can only attend remotely. Selected sessions may be recorded for later viewing.

## **SUBMISSION TYPES**

- Oral presentations: Presenters will give a 20-minute talk, followed by 10 minutes of questions.
- Interactive poster presentations: A small number of posters will be presented in each session, in which each presenter will give a brief overview of their work. The presentations will be followed by time for active discussion.

## **SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

The abstract submission deadline is July 31, 2022.

Please submit a word document including title, the names of all authors and a 250-word abstract. Please also indicate the corresponding author, contact information and your preferred submission type (oral or poster presentation).
